Change of ambassador

There is a change of ambassador coming up in Berlin. Joseph John Mpinganjira will end his tenure as ambassador in mid-February 2026 and leave the country in mid-March. Nothing is known yet about his future or his successor.

New visa fees

Following the announcement and now publication in the Malawi Gazette Supplement, the new visa fees apply with immediate effect:

Transit and single entry US\$50.00,
Multiple entry within 6 months US\$150.00,
Multiple entry within 12 months US\$250.00.
Visas ‘on arrival’ and ‘e-visas’ are still available.
